You are hereby summonsed to attend a meeting of the Parish Council on **Monday 25th November 2013 at 7.45pm** in the Village Hall, St Peters. The business to be transacted is set out in this agenda. Members of the public are cordially invited to attend and may address the Council at the Chairman's discretion.

Agenda.

- (1) **Apologies for Absence:** To formally receive any apology for absence.
- (2) **Declarations of Interest:** Members to declare interests, including those previously registered under the Code of Conduct requirements, and also to consider any formal request from Members for dispensation in respect of disclosable pecuniary interests.
- (3) **Adoption of Minutes:** To agree and adopt the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 28th October 2013.
- (4) **Planning Matters:** Council will be asked to address any new consultations, and any other current planning issue, as well as any SDWP update available.
- (5) **Administrative Matters & Correspondence:**
 - (a) The Clerk will present relevant correspondence, which will be available to Members, together with any outstanding administrative matters requiring attention.
 - (b) Notice from County Council of a proposal to withdraw rural bus service grants which could seriously affect vital bus services serving St Peters. Members will be asked to agree a response and ratify the urgent process already taken to deal with this consultation.
 - (c) To receive and consider correspondence from St Peters Village Hall Association. Members may, in view of the legal issues involved, resolve (following a formal proposal), to deal with this as an exempt item and accordingly exclude the press and the public. The Chairman may decide to defer this item to the end of the meeting.
 - (d) Newslink update.
 - (e) Parish Survey and results update.
- (6) **Warden's Report and Friends of Power Park ;**

To receive a report from the Warden and an update from FOPP, as well as to consider any process by which more support for future needs and requirements can be met.
- (7) **Accounts, Financial Matters:**
 - (a) To consider payment of accounts received and presented at the meeting, and to address any other urgent financial matter.

Council is advised by the County Association to defer formally setting any precept until the Minister's official statement on precepts is made known later in the year. Members may wish to consider budget proposals at the discretion of the Chairman. At the time of publishing this agenda no information has yet been received from the City Council in respect of the anticipated 'Benefits Grant' award to St Peters.
