- (1) **Apologies for Absence:** To formally receive any apology for absence.
- (2) **Declarations of Interest:** Members to declare interests, including those previously registered under the Code of Conduct requirements, and also to consider any formal request from Members for dispensation in respect of disclosable pecuniary interests.
- (3) **Adoption of Minutes:** To agree and adopt the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 25th November 2013.
- (4) **Planning Matters:** Council will be asked to address any new consultations, and any other current planning issue, as well as any SDWP update available. The Chairman and Vice Chairman will report on a meeting they had with County Officers in respect of the Ketch traffic island plans, as well as the plans for the partial dualling of Broomhall Way.
- (5) **Administrative Matters & Correspondence:**
 - (a) The Clerk will present relevant correspondence, which will be available to Members, together with any outstanding administrative matters requiring attention.
 - (b) Any receive any update on the County Council proposal to withdraw rural bus service grants .
 - (c) To receive and approve the proposed final settlement of outstanding invoice figures from the St Peters Village Hall Association.
 - (d) Newslink update and any feedback from the Parish Survey report contained therein.

Members are reminded that any decision in respect of precept will need careful consideration of their interests afore-hand.
