Next months work:

Community Engagement Officer (Wardening). SLA has been written and signed. We have offered the vacant post to Tracy Sutton, and we await references and notice period before we can confirm a start date. In the meantime Heath Bayliss has found alternative employment and so there is a vacancy. Warwick is looking to recruit casual labour as cover and will balance any short term reduction in labour over the coming months. (**Action: Warwick**)

Fishes area of Parish. County have agreed to fund footpath work at Lusty Glaze and will meet with DWT on site. There is an Oak tree at Lusty Glaze which needs work to it, so Alex will arrange for a contractor to quote. (**Action: Alex**). Mike reported that the land to the North was in the ownership of Betts Ecology and that some works were still outstanding. County are willing to adopt the footpath, but require Severn Trent to complete some works before adoption can take place.

- Parish litter bin to installed.

- Investigated maintenance plans for Abbotsbury court tidy up.

- St Peters Festival. Need to order banners and posters. Wet day layout to be drawn up.
- Community Engagement Officer (Wardening). Offered role, await clearance from references etc. before confirmation of start date.
- Cycle rack replacement for Parish Hall.
- Tidy up of bank and undergrowth opposite the old Homebase store Bath RD; where the path returns back from the road into St Perters estate. Work booked in for 23rd April
